Hch 4, 8-12

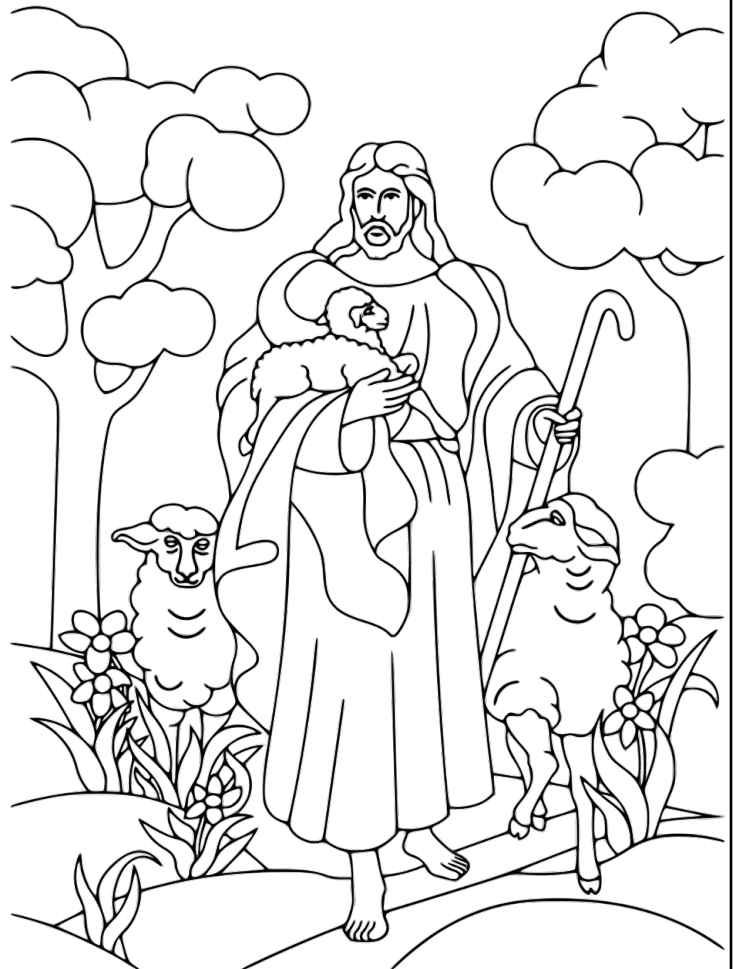

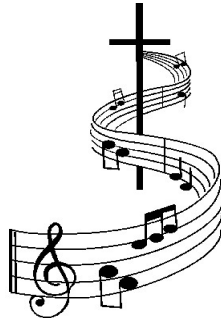
